Aloha e Ms. Sokugawa:

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) has been recently apprised of community concerns regarding a development project at the subject parcel that may negatively impact cultural resources and iwi kūpuna (human remains/burials). It is our understanding that the subject permit was approved without affording the State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) the opportunity to review and comment on the project, pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes (HRS) § 6E-42 and Hawai'i Administrative Rules (HAR) § 13-284.

OHA is requesting that the DPP issue a Stop Work Order for all work conducted on the subject parcel until the permit is submitted to SHPD for review and the historic preservation review process is completed in accordance with HRS § 6E-42 and HAR § 13-284.
